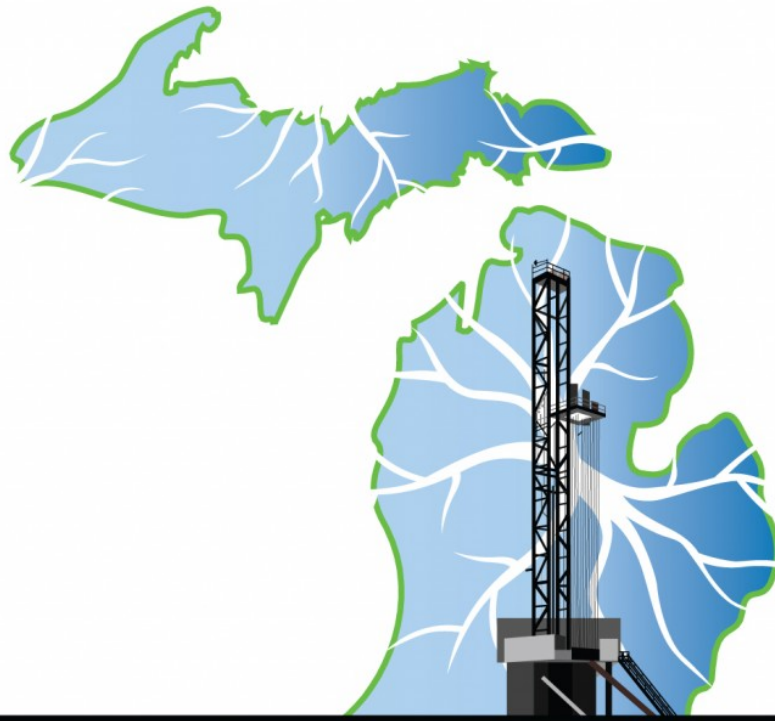


Ballot Initiative to Ban Fracking in Michigan
